

COMPUTER ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The use of the District’s computers is a privilege, not a right, and inappropriate use will result in cancellation of those privileges. The principal will make all decisions regarding whether or not a user has violated this Authorization and may deny, revoke, or suspend access at any time. The building principal’s decision is final. Students sign an acceptable use policy which is in effect during their year(s) in the District.

Some examples of unacceptable uses are, but not limited to:

- Using the computer without adult permission
- Installing or downloading ANY software without the express permission to do so
- Using the network for any illegal activity including violation of copyright or transmitting any material in violation of any US or state regulation
- Using another user’s account, password, or computer
- Invading the privacy of other individuals
- Downloading or posting copyright material for other than personal educational use
- Accessing, downloading or posting any defamatory, inaccurate, abusive, obscene, profane, sexually oriented, threatening, racially offensive, harassing, or illegal material,
- Using the network for private financial or commercial gain
- Posting anonymous messages
- Using the network while access privileges are suspended or revoked
- Chat or instant messaging is prohibited.
