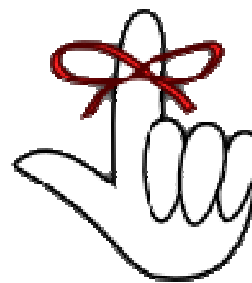

## Pre-Kindergarten Screening

North Pekin/Marquette Heights School District #102 will be conducting a spring screening for the B.E.A.R.S. prekindergarten program. The screening dates will be Thursday, May 17 & Friday, May 18. You may call for an appointment beginning April 23, 2018. All three and four year old children who reside in the district are eligible for screening. All children must be three by May 1, 2018, to qualify for this screening. Another screening for children, who will be three before school begins, will be held in August 2018.

## Physicals & Dental Exams

All students entering sixth grade for the 2018-2019 school year must have a physical exam. The state now requires doctors to do a diabetes screening during the physical. They are also required to get the DTaP immunization. We cannot accept any physical that has not had this done. Please check with the doctor to make sure it is marked on the physical. **In the past we have had a doctor come to Georgetowne to do sports physicals, this service is no longer provided to the district.**

Also, all students entering sixth grade for the 2018-2019 school year must have a **dental** exam. If you have any questions, please call the school at 382-3401. If you need a physical or dental form, they are available in the office.

## Dental Services

Rogers will be participating in the Dental Sealant Program again this year. Dental Sealants & More will be at Rogers on **Thursday, May 10 for dental exams**. A dental exam is required for sixth grade; these exams meet the requirements of the state mandated dental exam. Information along with a permission form was sent home in March.
