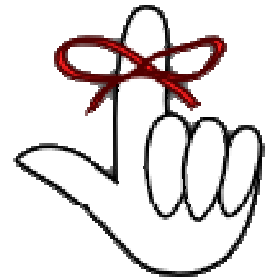

School Calendar Change

District 102 has used three emergency days this year. As a result, please note that the current year's school calendar has also changed. Here are the new dates for the final week of school.

- Mon., May 27 – No School, Memorial Day
- Tues., May 28 – Regular Dismissal Schedule
- Wed., May 29 – Regular Dismissal Schedule
- Thurs., May 30 – Last Day of School, 11:00/11:30 Dismissal
- Fri., May 31 – Teacher Institute

Of course, these changes are only final if no more emergency days are used this year. If the district is forced to cancel more days of school due to weather, the last possible day of school would be Monday, June 3 with a Teacher Institute on June 4.

Treats and Gifts at School

Due to health concerns treats and snacks for birthdays or holiday parties must be arranged in advance with the classroom teacher. All treats and snacks must be store bought and prepackaged in individual servings. No homemade treats or snacks are allowed at school. Treats and snacks may not require refrigeration and must have a clearly printed list of ingredients on the packaging.

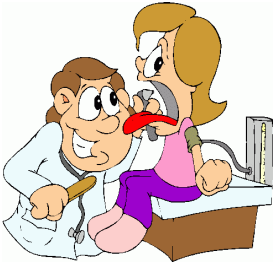
We discourage gifts of any kind such as flowers, balloons or candy delivered to the school for students. The student may not have them in class and it is difficult for students to transport such items home.

Physicals & Dental Exams

All students entering sixth grade for the 2019/2020 school year must have a physical exam. The state now requires doctors to do a diabetes screening during the physical. They are also required to get the DTaP immunization. We cannot accept any physical that has not had this done. Please check with the doctor to make sure it is marked on the physical.

Also, all students entering sixth grade for the 2019/2020 school year must have a **dental** exam.

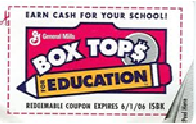
Teacher Appreciation Week
