Treats and Gifts at School

Due to health concerns treats and snacks for birthdays or holiday parties must be arranged in advance with the classroom teacher. All treats and snacks must be store bought and prepackaged in individual servings. No homemade treats or snacks are allowed at school. Treats and snacks may not require refrigeration and must have a clearly printed list of ingredients on the packaging.

We discourage gifts of any kind such as flowers, balloons or candy delivered to the school for students. The student may not have them in class and it is difficult for students to transport such items home.

Daylight Savings Time

Daylight saving time is the practice of advancing clocks during summer months by one hour so that evening daylight lasts an hour longer. This year daylight savings is on Sunday, March 12.

Physicals & Dental Exams

All students entering sixth grade for the 2017-2018 school year must have a physical exam. Physicals can be done any time after September 1, 2016. The state now requires doctors to do a diabetes screening during the

physical. They are also required to get the DTaP immunization. We cannot accept any physical that has not had this done. Please check with the doctor to make sure it is marked on the physical.

Also, all students entering sixth grade for the 2017-2018 school year must have a **dental** exam. Dental exams can be done any time after September 1, 2016.
