Physicals & Dental Exams

All students entering sixth grade for the 2018-2019 school year must have a physical exam. The state now requires doctors to do a diabetes screening during the physical. They are also required to get the DTaP immunization. We cannot accept any physical that has not had this done. Please check with the doctor to make sure it is marked on the physical. **In the past we have had a doctor come to Georgetowne to do sports physicals, this service is no longer provided to the district.**

Also, all students entering sixth grade for the 2018-2019 school year must have a **dental** exam.

Dental Services

Rogers will be participating in the Dental Sealant Program again this year. Dental Sealants & More will be at Rogers on **Thursday, May 10 for dental exams**. The permission forms for the exams are due by May 7, they will not be excepted the day of the exams. A dental exam is required for sixth grade; these exams meet the requirements of the state mandated dental exam. Information along with a permission form was sent home in March.

Pre-Kindergarten Screening

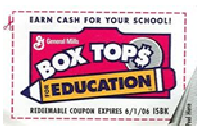
