Parents/Visitors



All RES entrances are secured. Anyone visiting RES are asked to enter through the main entrance. Proceed immediately to the main office.

Parents and visitors

should inform office personnel of their reason for being at school and await confirmation before proceeding further. Visitors must sign in, identifying their name, the date and time of arrival, and the classroom or location they are visiting. Approved visitors must take a tag identifying themselves as a guest and place the tag to their outer clothing in a clearly visible location. Visitors are required to proceed immediately to their location in a quiet manner. All visitors must return to the main office and sign out before leaving the school. Visitors are expected to abide by all school rules during their time on school property. Access will be denied at school discretion. A visitor who fails to conduct himself or herself in a manner that is appropriate will be asked to leave and may be subject to criminal penalties for trespass and/or disruptive behavior.
