## Important Reminder:

As we are in the last half of the 2018-19 school year we would like to remind parents of the absentee procedure:

Please call 382-3456 and leave a message before 9:00 am for your child's absence, if this call or prior notice is not taken your child's absence will be marked unexcused. Students will be considered tardy if they are not in their classroom before the bell rings at the beginning of each school day. 2 tardies will result in a warning letter home to parents, 3-8 tardies student will receive a lunch detention, 9-12 tardies student receive one hour detention after school, and 13+ tardies results in possible suspension.

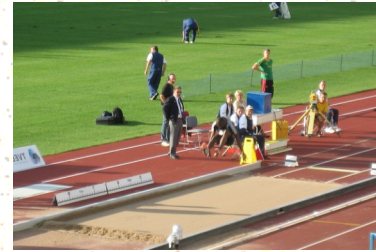
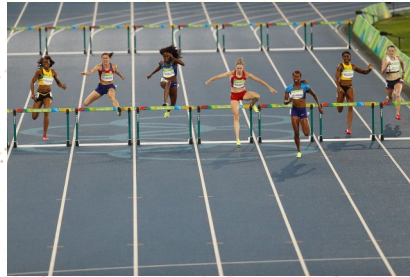


Track practice begins on Monday, March 4th. All participants must have a current physical on file in the office in order to participate
