## Reporting Absence from School

Please call 382-3612, ext. 230, before 9:00 a.m., to report your child's absence from school.



The school must contact parents whenever a child is absent. If we are not able to confirm an absence, it will be a considered an unexcused absence. If there are multiple unexcused absences, a truancy officer will be contacted.

## Visitor Procedures

Please make sure you always check in at the office when you are visiting or picking up your child from MES. This allows for your and other children's safety in the school. Parents are asked not to attempt to go to classrooms after the school day begins.

#### Change in Dismissal

If your child's dismissal changes, please send a



note to your child's teacher. We will only alter their normal dismissal procedure if we are notified by an adult. If an <u>emergency</u> arises and alternate plans must be used for picking up your child, please call the office before 2:30 p.m. Non-emergency changes in the child's routine should be explained to the child before school and with a written note to the teacher.

#### Morning Arrival Times and Tardies

Students walking to school or being driven by their parents should not arrive before 8:10 a.m. If your child is eating breakfast at school, it will be served between 7:50 a.m. and 8:10 a.m. Children are allowed to enter the building through the front or north doors, if the weather is inclement. An "IN" sign will be displayed on the outer doors on these days. Please help the school by making sure your child is on time, by 8:20. We only had 5 tardies in August!

# Dropping off Students before School

In order to maintain a safe environment for our students, starting SEPTEMBER 1, please drop your child off at the door and allow them to go to their classroom, wait in the hallway (when weather does not allow them to stay outside) or go to breakfast independently. This will allow all students to safely pass in the hall, and help us more carefully monitor who is coming in and out of the building. We are also hoping this will encourage more responsibility and independence for our students. There is school staff present to monitor students in the morning. We ask pre-k parents to remain with their children until Miss Jenny and Miss Rachel pick them up. Pre-k is the only grade level that requires an adult to wait with the children, inside or outside, for supervision.

#### Sending Treats to School

The Tazewell County Health Department recommends that all treats at school should be prepackaged or store purchased items. Pre-k and Kindergarten is asking parents to NOT send cupcakes to school. Please think of healthy alternatives for birthday snacks when at all possible. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

#### <u>NO SMOKING</u>

Smoking is prohibited on the school grounds at all times. Please do not smoke on school grounds. This includes vaping.
