Objectives

- Perform in several quality performances throughout the school year.
- Improve individual musical ability (tone production, intonation, music literacy, musical interpretation, technique).
- Acquire a greater knowledge of quality musical literature.

Materials

- Music/Folder (provided)
- Instrument (Band)
- Pencil
- Concert attire (GMS band/chorus shirt (order forms available), tan/khaki dress pants, long solid black socks, and solid black shoes). Students without the required attire at a performance will either not be allowed to perform and/or receive a lowered grade depending on the infraction.

Rules/Expectations

- Be on time with music/instrument when the bell rings.
- Sit in assigned seat with required materials.
- Show respect to the director and fellow musicians.
- Show respect to all school property.
- Be responsible for your own actions.
- No food/drinks/gum, etc. are allowed in the music department.
- Cell phones or other items/devices that interrupt rehearsal are not allowed.
- Be prepared for all rehearsals...PRACTICE!!!
- Music will be learned and memorized (chorus) for performances.
- Attend all performances. If a student is absent from a performance, a parent/guardian must notify the director. The director reserves the right to deem the absence excused or unexcused.

Communication

Parent/teacher communication is very important. Please contact Mr. Woods or Mrs. Woods with any questions and/or concerns. Communication to parents and students from the directors will be through various methods including Class Dojo, email, district website, and written notes sent home with students.

Grading

- Grades will be based on attendance, improvement, supply checks and performance tests.

 - -Parades (Band)

 - -Rehearsals/Lessons (Band)
 - -Specialty Performances (Advance notice will be given.)

Add/Drop Policy

Membership in the GMS Music Department is a privilege. The directors reserve the right to add and remove students from the ensembles if necessary. Students that continually miss rehearsals and performances will be removed from the ensemble. No student may drop out of the GMS Band or Choral Program at any time during the year without permission from the director, the parent/guardian, and the building principal. Students will not be allowed to return to the group for the remainder of the year if they leave the ensemble at any time throughout the year.
