Please work with your child on their skip counting at home. If the students can skip count easily, multiplication and division are much easier for them to do.

On Wednesday, we will be having an intruder drill. This will teach the students how to hide and behave in our classroom if an intruder were to get into the building.

Homework reminder

- ✓ This week the students will have spelling words. A letter explaining spelling will be coming home on Monday.
- ✓ Math homework will be sent home on Monday.
- ✓ Students will have a math quiz over lessons 4-6 on Monday. (We always review in the morning, then take the quiz after lunch.)
