Please call 382-3456 and leave a message before 9:00 am for your child's absence, if this call or prior notice is not taken your child's absence will be marked <u>unexcused</u>. Students will be considered tardy if they are not in their classroom before the bell rings at the beginning of each school day. 2 tardies will result in a warning letter home to parents, 3-8 tardies student will receive a lunch detention, 9-12 tardies student receives a one hour detention after school, and 13+ tardies results in possible suspension.
