COMMITTEE DISCUSSION ITEMS

Building and Grounds

Mrs. Lindsay informed the Board the application for the improvements to the MES gym/cafeteria was submitted and has already been approved. She met with the architect to discuss the plan and bidding services.

Mrs. Lindsay notified the Board that GIVSCO reached out to confirm they are scheduled to begin mobilizing and foundation work over spring break. Mr. Hermacinski has been asked to coordinate with Waste Management to move the dumpsters. GIVSCO wants the current buildings empty by early June, so we may need to consider renting a POD for temporary storage.

Mrs. Lindsay notified the Board that she posted for proposals for mowing services.

Transportation

Mrs. Lindsay reviewed bus lease/purchase proposals with the Board. The Board discussed warranties and possible use of buses beyond 5-years should it decide to purchase buses.

Finance

Mrs. Lindsay provided the Board with budget summary reports for November and December of the current fiscal year.

Mrs. Lindsay updated the Board on discussions of the one cent sales facility tax appearing on the November election ballot.

Mrs. Lindsay updated the Board on conversations and reflection that the administration team has shared following the concerns discussed during the January Board meeting.

Policy

Mrs. Lindsay shared a proposed mutual aid agreement between the Pekin Area School Districts for the provision of personnel, transportation, support and/or services in the event of emergency or crisis.

Academics & Professional Development

Mrs. Lindsay notified the Board that District staff will visit our arranged reunification site during the February SIP day.

Extra-Curricular Activities –
